

THE VILLAGE OF LIONS BAY

BY-LAW #67

A By-law to extend the due date of property taxes from July 2nd to July 14th.

WHEREAS it is provided under Section 384 of the Municipal Act that the Collector shall, as soon as is practicable on or after the 2nd day of July in each year unless other dates and percentage additions have been determined under subsection (2), add to the unpaid taxes of the current year, in respect of each parcel of land and the improvements thereon upon the real-property tax roll, ten per centum of the amount unpaid as of the day of July of that year.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Lions Bay enacts the following:

- (1) (a) That the due date of property taxes be changed to July 14th, after which date there will be an addition of 10% (ten) per centum on taxes unpaid.


(b) The said unpaid taxes, together with the amount or amounts added under this section, are deemed to be taxes of the current year due on such land and improvements thereon, and the amount or amounts added under this section when collected shall form part of the general revenue of the Municipality.
- (2) This By-law may be cited for all purposes as the Village of Lions Bay By-law #67 to extend the due date of property taxes.
- (3) This by-law shall be effective in the year 1977 and in the succeeding years until amended or repealed.

READ a first time the 6th day of June, 1977.

READ a second time the 6th day of June, 1977.

READ a third time the 6th day of June, 1977.

Reconsidered, finally passed and adopted this 9th day of June, 1977.
