



THE MUNICIPALITY OF THE VILLAGE OF LIONS BAY

CLOSURE ORDER

WHEREAS:

- A. A communicable disease known as COVID-19 has emerged in British Columbia;
- B. SARS-CoV-2, an infectious agent, can cause outbreaks of serious illness known as COVID-19 among the public;
- C. A person infected with SARS-CoV-2 can infect other people with whom the infected person is in contact;
- D. The gathering of large numbers of people in close contact with one another can promote the transmission of SARS-CoV-2 and increase the number of people who develop COVID-19;
- E. Federal, Provincial and local health authorities have issued directives to maintain Social Distancing of at least two (2) meters;
- F. The Public Health Officer of British Columbia has issued an Order requiring land owners, including the Village of Lions Bay (the "Municipality"), to restrict gatherings of people in excess of 50 people at a place of which the Municipality is the owner, occupier or operator, or for which it is otherwise responsible.

NOW THEREFORE, and in accordance with the foregoing and Lions Bay Parks Regulation Bylaw No. 448, 2012, as amended:

All Village of Lions Bay Parks, including beach accesses, parking lots, playgrounds and public washrooms, of which the Municipality is the owner, occupier or operator, or for which it is otherwise responsible, are CLOSED, effective immediately.
