PUBLIC NOTICE is given to the electors of the Village of Lions Bay that an election will be held on Saturday, October 20, 2018. Nominations for the office of:

Mayor – one (1) to be elected Councillor – four (4) to be elected School Trustee – five (5) to be elected

for a four year term ending October 2022, will be received by the chief election officer or deputy chief election officer as follows:

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day, October 20, 2018
- Canadian citizen
- resident of British Columbia for at least six months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2018 general local elections, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply: **Mayor** \$10,000 **Councillor** \$5,000 **School Trustee** \$18,037.52

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2018 general local elections, the following third party advertising limits apply: **Mayor and Councillor** \$750 **School Trustee** \$901.88
