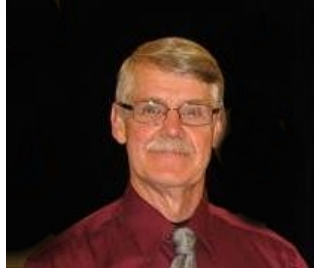


FRED BAIN

- Career Firefighter 1973 – 2003
 - Instructor in CPR(1979-2003) Industrial First Aid (IFA)(1983-1993), First Responders' First Aid(1993 - 2003)
 - Member of West Vancouver's Fire & Rescue Services Critical Incident Stress Management team (CISM) (1993 -2003)
 - Moved up through the ranks from Firefighter to Lieutenant to Captain, qualifying and acting as a District Chief
