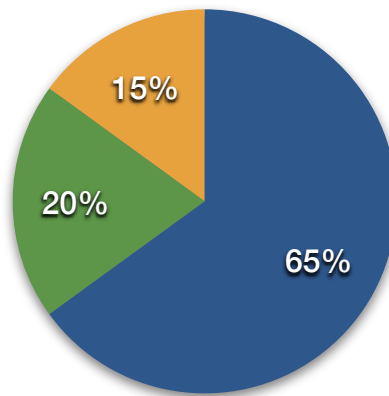

PARKING

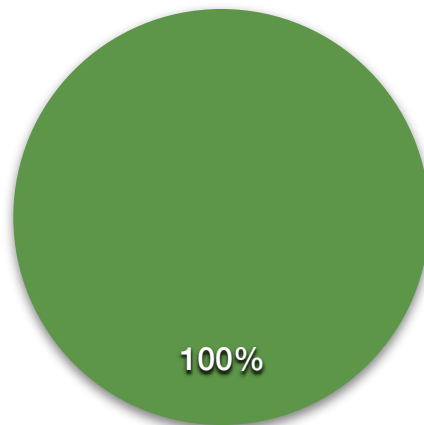
Question 1: Which of the following is your preferred option for non-resident parking management?

- Allocate parking for Non-Residents along the highway ONLY

Question 2: Do you want the roadway between three-way stop and the railway tracks to be widened to add additional Non-Resident parking?

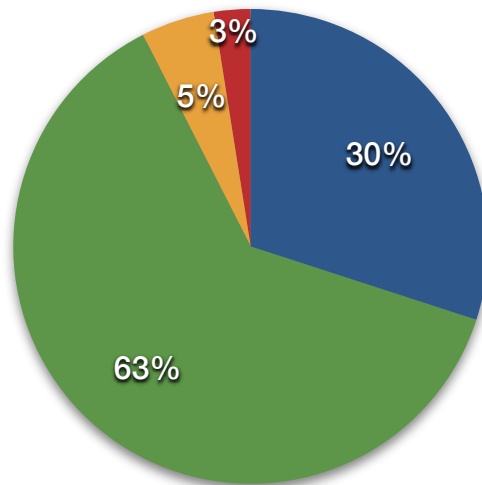
- Yes, I want the road widened for additional parking

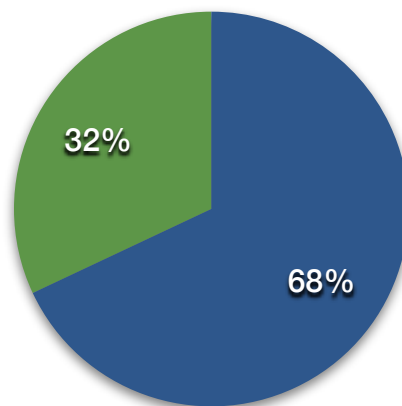

- Did not specify



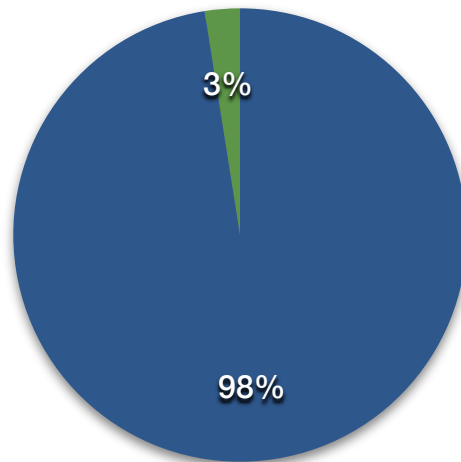
Question 3b: If you indicated the parking should be paid, what is your preference regarding time limits & monitoring?

Question 4: Currently, the Village of Lions Bay sells parking day passes that allow anyone to park in the limited Resident Only Permit spaces for a fee. Which course of action is preferable to you regarding this day pass system?

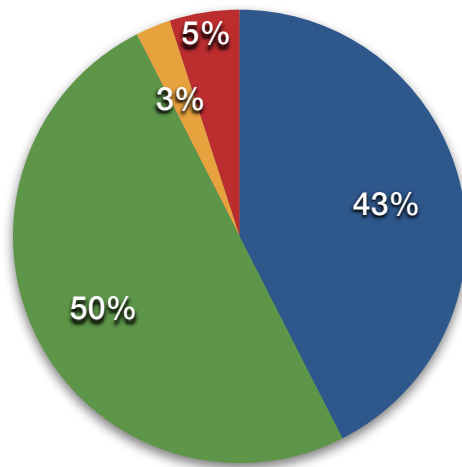
- Only allow day passes to be issued to Residents in need of extra parking spaces, with accompanying ID

FACILITIES

Question 5: Where do you want the new bear-proof garbage can to be installed?

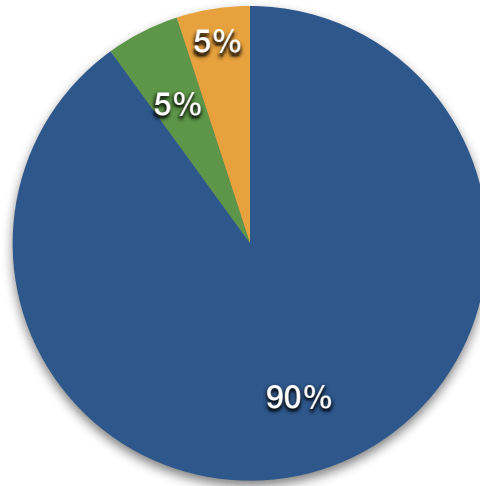
- DO NOT install an additional garbage can at Brunswick Beach

Question 6: Do you want a portable public toilet facility in Brunswick Beach?

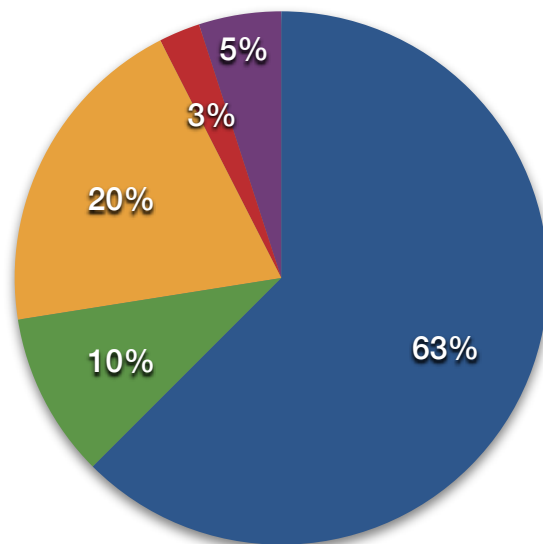
- No, I do not want a public toilet facility at Brunswick Beach

DOGS

Question 7: Should dogs be allowed on South Brunswick Beach under supervision and control of their owners?

- ONLY Resident's dogs should be permitted
- ALL dogs should be permitted (Non-Resident and Resident)*
- NO dogs should be permitted at all (including Resident's dogs)
- No opinion
- Other



* 1 resident specified that they are only in favour of Brunswick Beach resident's dogs being allowed on the beach (not dogs belonging to other Lions Bay residents) in order to make enforcement more feasible.

Question 8: Should dogs be allowed on Middle Beach under supervision and control of their owners?
