With reference to this item on the agenda for tomorrow's council meeting, we would ask that the following questions be raised:

Who is expected to be benefiting from this proposed car park:

- a) Brunswick Beach residents
- b) Lions Bay residents in general
- c) Non-residents of either area?

If council is NOT trying to encourage use of the beach by non-residents, then we suggest that having paid parking at the highway intersection is a very bad idea. If council is trying to encourage use of the beach by non-residents, we would ask why. We are sure council is aware that we have been struggling with the reputation of being a nudist beach for decades; there are more families with children living at Brunswick now and this move would only increase the problem for us.

If they are proposing it for Lions Bay residents only, then could it be made available ONLY to Lions Bay residents, and require a permit for their use rather than make it available to anyone for a fee.

In addition, we would ask why the council deems it appropriate to encourage any additional use of a beach that has no washroom facilities.
