

The shoreline looked pretty clear until you really started to look and this is what was found: 3 bottle caps, 22 cigarette butts, 1 coffee cup, a bucketful of food wrappers/small plastics, a bucketful of paper, 1 plastic bag, 1 six-pack

holder, 6 straws, 1 buoy piece, 15m of rope, a 1m x 1m piece of foam, a bucketful of foam pieces, a frisbee, a tyvek suit, 15m of rusted chain, 3 wires, 2 pieces of heavy duty metal cable, a tennis ball, and a large plastic sheet.
