CONSTRUCTION UPDATE



Construction of the new Harvey 512,000-gallon tank is well underway and the project is currently tracking on schedule with anticipated completion in late September or early October. Industria's crews have completed the foundation preparation and steelwork and poured the concrete base of the tank. The tank installers, H2flo, are preparing to erect the tank which is expected to be complete by the end of August. Shortly thereafter, crews will begin the final pipework and site preparation in order to commission the new tank. REMEMBER TO CONSERVE WATER

Residents are reminded that our water from the Harvey Creek Intake is currently being supplied by the much smaller 100,000-gallon Oceanview tank until the new tank is commissioned. That leaves us with significantly reduced firefighting water reserves. Please assist us during this construction period by reducing your water consumption to ensure as much of the water as possible remains within the 100,000-gallon tank for firefighting purposes.

Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience and bear with us as we see this critical infrastructure project through to completion. Thanks for your patience and understanding.

Homeowners in Lions Bay are permitted to put out two 77 L (20 gallon) garbage bins weighing no more than 20 kg (45 lbs) each. This ensures that Waste Control Services workers do not injure themselves when loading your garbage into their collection truck. If you have more than two containers put out, the additional container will not be picked up unless it is tagged. Tags for additional cans can be purchased at the Village Office. Each additional can costs \$4.00.

Sign up for the Municipality's Emergency Notification System

“Be in the know when it matters most”



BE PREPARED TO RECEIVE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SIGN UP FOR LBAAlert TODAY

Some time ago the Village of Lions Bay provided you the chance to sign up for LBAAlert, a free emergency notification system that provides quick and concise updates about adverse emergency events that may impact you or your loved ones.

Creating and activating an account only takes a few moments of your time and you only need to provide a few pieces of information. To start the process visit our [website](#) and fill out our simple sign up form. Here you will provide us with your name, email address and what neighbourhood you live in. After submitting our sign-up form you will receive an email from ePACT, the emergency notification service provider utilized by local governments like Lions Bay, Squamish and the SLRD.

Complete the sign-up process by creating your ePACT account so that you can receive emergency messages from LBAAlert. **Your phone number and email address will only be used to contact you through the LBAAlert system.**

Some residents have started the process of signing up for LBAAlert but have not created their ePACT account to complete the process. Please do so as soon as possible so we can begin to utilize LBAAlert to its fullest potential in the event of an emergency or a disaster.

Once you finish the registration process, you will receive emergency messaging by LBAAlert only if:

1. there is an emergency/disaster that requires you to take or be prepared to take action to protect yourself and your loved ones, or
2. there is a test of the LBAalert system, scheduled to occur twice per year in October and May.
