## Updates from the Municipality

### HARVEY CREEK WATER TANK CONSTRUCTION

*update*



The lengthy deconstruction of the old Harvey Creek water tank is completed, and the new concrete foundation has been poured. For a time-lapse video of the work so far, [click here](#). The next step of the project is for H2flo, the tank manufacturer, to assemble the new 512,000-gallon tank, panel by panel. Construction begins with the bolting together of the first layer of glass-fused steel panels and then installing the domed roof. Once this is done, the first layer and the roof are raised using jacks with the new layer being constructed below the others. This continues until the 40-foot-high tank is completed. H2flow is estimating this will take between two to three weeks.

**\*\*\* CONSTRUCTION NOISE TO INCREASE \*\*\***

Our contractors have asked that we let you know construction noise will increase as the panels require numerous bolts to fasten them together. We request your forbearance as this critical project enters this erection phase of construction.

**\*\*\* LIMITED WATER AVAILABILITY ON AUGUST 27 \*\*\***

**On Tuesday, August 27, 2019, between 10:00 am and 3:00 pm**, Industria's construction crews will be working to replace 3 critical valves between the treatment plant and the new water tank. Unfortunately, portions of this **work will require the water system to be shut down**. During this time, residents will be supplied by a very limited quantity of water in the Oceanview Tank. Please plan ahead and restrict all non-essential use of water between these times – i.e. do not water gardens or wash cars, decks, or driveways; refrain from flushing toilets if possible; put off showers and laundry until after 3:00 pm; and generally conserve as much water as you are able.

**WE ARE ON LEVEL 2 WATER CONSERVATION**

Residents are reminded that our water from the Harvey Creek Intake is currently being supplied by the much smaller 100,000-gallon Oceanview tank until the new tank is commissioned. That leaves us with significantly reduced firefighting water reserves. Please assist us during this construction period by reducing your water consumption to ensure as much of the water as possible remains within the 100,000-gallon tank for firefighting purposes. Please accept our apologies for any inconvenience and bear with us as we see this critical infrastructure project through to completion. Thanks for your patience and understanding.

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## Sign up for the Municipality's Emergency Notification System

### **BE PREPARED TO RECEIVE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SIGN UP FOR LBALEERT TODAY**

Some time ago the Village of Lions Bay provided you the chance to sign up for LBAAlert, a free emergency notification system that provides quick and concise updates about adverse emergency events that may impact you or your loved ones.

Creating and activating an account only takes a few moments of your time and you only need to provide a few pieces of information. To start the process visit our [website](#) and fill out our simple sign up form. Here you will provide us with your name, email address and what neighbourhood you live in. After submitting our sign-up form you will receive an email from ePACT, the emergency notification service provider utilized by local governments like Lions Bay, Squamish and the SLRD.

Complete the sign-up process by creating your ePACT account so that you can receive emergency messages from LBAAlert. **Your phone number and email address will only be used to contact you through the LBAAlert system.**

Some residents have started the process of signing up for LBAAlert but have not created their ePACT account to complete the process. Please do so as soon as possible so we can begin to utilize LBAAlert to its fullest potential in the event of an emergency or a disaster.

Once you finish the registration process, you will receive emergency messaging by LBAAlert only if:

1. there is an emergency/disaster that requires you to take or be prepared to take action to protect yourself and your loved ones, or
2. there is a test of the LBAalert system, scheduled to occur twice per year in October and May.
