Nominations for the province's highest honour, the Order of British Columbia, are now being accepted. This prestigious honour recognizes individuals who have demonstrated outstanding achievement, excellence or distinction in a field of endeavour benefiting the people of the province or elsewhere.

Nomination forms for the Order are available [online](#) or by emailing the Honours and Awards Secretariat at <mailto:bchonoursandawards@gov.bc.ca>. Nominations must be received by **Friday, March 6, 2020**. Submissions received after this date will be considered in 2021.

To nominate a British Columbian for the Order of B.C., you can use the [online nomination process](#) or you can complete the [PDF form](#) and submit it electronically or by mail to the Secretariat. For more information on what must be included with your nomination and for tips on how to write a compelling nomination please refer to the Order of B.C.'s [website](#).

In addition to the Order of B.C., you may also nominate individuals for the province's other honour, the Medal of Good Citizenship. This medal recognizes citizens for their exceptional long-term service, and contributions to their communities without expectation of remuneration or reward. The medal reflects their generosity, service, acts of selflessness and contributions to community life. Nominations are accepted year-round and the nomination form can be found [here](#).

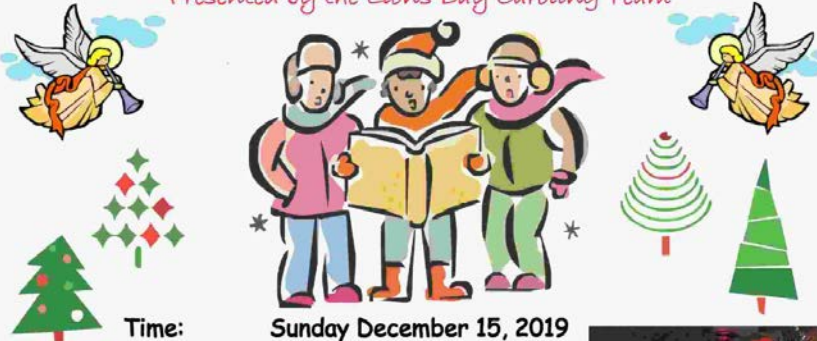
