## DIRTY? WATER?



### **Dirty or Rust Coloured Water**

On Sunday, Lions Bay Fire Rescue checked several fire hydrants on Creekview Place and Highview Place resulting in some turbulence within the surrounding water mains. This stirred up iron and mineral deposits in the mains leading to dirty or rust coloured water. Public Works crews attended and flushed several water mains to eliminate this discoloured water; however, some residences are still experiencing dirty water.

If this is the case, run your cold water tap for a few minutes until the water is clear. If it is not clear the first time, wait a few minutes and repeat this process until your water runs clear.

**Your water is safe to drink.**

There are no health concerns associated with discolored water from hydrant flushing. Avoid washing clothes until the water clears as the discoloured water may stain laundry. If this happens, keep clothes wet and treat them with stain remover.
