### Deferring your 2020 Property Taxes

Tax deferment is a low interest loan program that helps qualified B.C. homeowners pay their annual property taxes on their principal residence. Eligible home owners may apply to have the Provincial Government pay the current year's residential property taxes for their principal residence. If a home owner chooses to defer their taxes, the Municipality is paid by the Province, rather than by the homeowner. 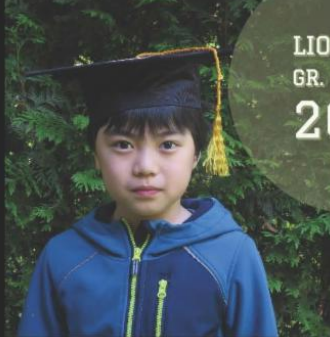

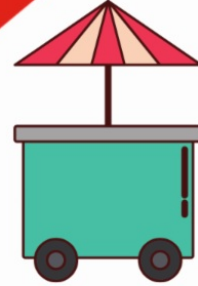
