### NOTICE OF POSSIBLE PUBLIC EXPOSURE TO COVID-19

Vancouver Coastal Health has advised of possible public exposure to COVID-19 at the Lions Bay Beach Park during daytime hours on the following dates: **July 26, 27, 29, 30 and 31**. See: <http://www.vch.ca/covid-19/public-exposures>.

The possible exposures listed on this webpage, including the Lions Bay Beach Park, are *believed to be low risk* and Public Health officials will follow up on all known contact information but, out of an abundance of caution, they ask that anyone who may have visited the beach park *on the specified dates and times to monitor themselves for symptoms*.

There is no known risk to anyone who attended outside of the specified dates and times. If people remain healthy and do not develop any symptoms, there is no need to self-isolate and people can continue with their usual daily activities. If you develop any symptoms of COVID-19, please seek testing and then self-isolate and follow the rest of the advice on the VCH webpage.

Many of you are aware of this information already and of affected local residents. It is important for everyone to remember the keys to [safer social interactions](#) during this pandemic.



**REMEMBER**  
**Fewer faces, bigger spaces**

Limit your social group to 5 – 10 people outside of your household members, maintain a safe distance (2 metres) from those outside your household or social group, wash your hands often and don't touch your face. Public Works would like to remind you that we are currently under Water Conservation Level 1 which is in effect until September 30, 2020.

Under Level 1, sprinkling can occur between 4 a.m. - 9 a.m. as follows:

- Even numbered addresses on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays
- Odd numbered addresses on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays

Watering your garden, washing your cars, boats, or outdoor surfaces including buildings and driveways is permitted but please use a hose equipped with spring-loaded shut off.

[See Schedule A](#) of the [Outdoor Water Use Bylaw No. 484, 2016](#) for a reminder of what is applicable under each conservation level. Watering your lawn outside of allowed times and without a water exemption permit could result in a \$100 fine.

*Most lawns only need about one inch of water per week, including rainfall. This is equal to one hour of watering.*
