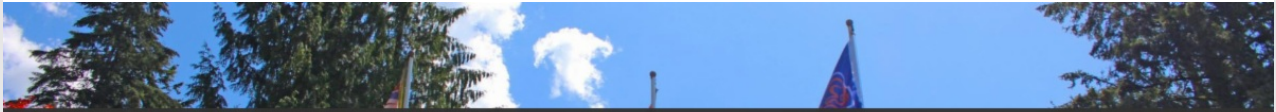

Property Tax Penalty Reminder



Reminder notices have been mailed out this week to all property owners with outstanding 2020 property taxes. The second penalty of 8% will be applied to any unpaid 2020 taxes on September 2. The first penalty of 2% was applied July 15. To avoid the second penalty, payment must be received by September 1. See [here](#) for methods of payment.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION

Aug. 25th & 26th

Isleview Road Construction – August 25th and 26th

This coming Tuesday and Wednesday, August 25th and 26th respectively, Public Works will be excavating the roadway at 60 Isleview Place for the purposes of installing a new water service to the property. Construction will begin at 8:00 am and finish at 3:00 pm each day. Public Works will be using steel road plates to ensure one lane of traffic remains open at all times; however, there may be periodic delays where full closure is required. Public Works will strive to keep any such disturbances to a maximum of 10

minutes.

Please plan ahead for any appointments or meetings by ensuring you have enough time to incorporate a 10-minute delay and please keep your speed at a maximum of 15 km/h as you pass through the work zone.

Face Masks Required Starting August 24

Beginning Monday, August 24, non-medical masks or face coverings will be required when on board transit vehicles. There are *some exclusions* to this mandate including:

- Persons unable to place or remove a mask or face covering without assistance;
- Children under 5 years of age;
- Transit employees working behind a physical barrier or within areas designated for employees and not for public access (including Bus Operators while driving behind a barrier);
- Police, employees, or first responders in an emergency.

If you or someone under your care is exempt, please pick up an exemption card from the Compass Customer Service Centres at Stadium–Chinatown and Waterfront stations. If you are not able to visit a Compass Customer Service Centre, please [contact Translink](#) to discuss what options could be available.
