An Update from Public Works

ROAD LINE PAINTING THIS WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 30, 2020

This **Wednesday, September 30, 2020**, Scottish Line Painting will be painting traffic markings around the Village. The work is scheduled **between 7:00 am and 4:00 pm**. Scottish will be painting **crosswalks and stop bars** throughout the Village as well as a **complete re-do of the parking at the Village Office / Broughton Hall complex**. There will be **no parking at this facility during this timeframe**. Please note there may be minor traffic interruptions in some areas as needed – crews ask that you slow down and stay well behind the line painting truck. Also, be patient and obey the instructions of any line painting personnel or traffic control personnel.

Line Painting Facts:

- It takes approximately 3 minutes for traffic paint to dry;
- Wet traffic paint on the road may splatter on your vehicle if you cross the line before the paint has dried;
- If your vehicle is splattered with paint, go to a car wash as soon as possible;
- If paint does not wash off, spray the affected area with WD-40 and allow it to dry for 2 hours, then re-wash the affected area;
- If the paint remains, consider submitting a claim to your insurer.

The Village of Lions Bay will not be liable for claims for road paint overspray onto adjacent cars parked within any Temporary No Parking areas or claims from motorists who cross wet paint lines.
