6. Business Arising from the Minutes

A. Discover Lions Bay walking tour map and QR signs (Vanessa and Katelynn report) Vanessa McLaughlin reports that Alex the graphic designer has made several changes as requested by the committee :

- Pool removed from the beach
- The font improved for better readability
- Three street names included, Bayview, Isleview and Lions Bay Ave to facilitate easier orientation

The Map will be forwarded to committee for feedback to Vanessa

Ute shared Lions Bay Arts banners with committee and she will collaborate with Vanessa to determine if any part of the banners can be incorporated with both the Map and QR signs.

Victoria asked if the maps would be made available in a printed format. Katelynn will investigate if this is possible.

Vanessa shared QR sign options to committee of which there were 4 . Most members agreed with the first option shown (bright Green option). Only other comment was to possibly change the “Harvey Creek” portion to white.

The potential of sponsorship of the signs was raised but no consensus reached at this time . The thought was to readdress next meeting . Timing of the map being launched is still contingent on The Wade Park memorial event .

Ute will contact Brenda Broughton to ask if any update on this. Turn around time for the signs to be made up should be about two weeks.

Budget for this project has slightly exceeded initial estimate approx \$300 more to make changes requested for current version and it is estimated approx \$200 more for any additional tweaking.

B. Website :

Katelynn will coordinate with Karla at the village office.

C. Fishing Derby:

Ute met with “Mortgage Dave” and the proposal is to have an event running from dawn to 3pm in September the same day as the fire-fighters event with any money raised being donated to the firefighters . The events will be organized separately
Lions Bay Arts will donate \$250 for a logo competition for the event.

All plans for this event going ahead this year are contingent on the fishing reopening in Howe Sound (currently closed) otherwise it will be postponed until March 2022.

D. Yoga in the Park :

Katelynn submitted a formal request to Lululemon to sponsor this event but the company is currently not running events. An August or September event may be possible.

E. Lions Bay 50th Anniversary Video :

No report on this, Ute will contact Lori Atherton for update.

F. Centennial signs :

Complete and in place.

G. Time Capsule :

Natalie Mendez from LB School is in touch with Jamie Cunliffe and will coordinate the project some time in October.

H. Swag : Ute to follow up with Lori.

I. Interpretive map from the School :
John Dudley in charge of organizing this. It is to be digitalized and mounted on Centennial trail near the other Village map.

J. Scarecrow competition :
Complete and all scarecrows removed from the forest . Villagers who participated did a great job of removing all debris.

K. Olympic Rally :
Victoria Rogers reporting on this ,
To be held at the Lions Bay School Ground July 23rd (The opening of the Olympic Games) 6-8pm
Assuming BC restrictions on outside gatherings due to COVID are changed as of July 1st Victoria is hoping to host an event where up to 500 people could attend .
She is working with Leslie Nolin on logistics but in essence the event is to be a picnic whereby participants bring their own food and chairs. This is not an exclusive Lions Bay event welcoming others from outside the village. There will be some messages by former olympians, some olympic swag to give out music, balloons and cake and possibly some crafts for the kids.

Portable toilets, parking, RCMP . Filming the event amongst other considerations are being discussed and planned for .

Victoria questioned if a banner would be in order as a legacy item .

She is requesting that the 50th anniversary committee commit to assist for the expenses for this event which she estimates will be \$2,500 .

The committee agreed once Ute discusses the update of our budget with Lori Atherton we will respond to Victoria's request via email.

Ron McLaughlin suggested for advertising in the Village Update Victoria may get better exposure by having a separate and exclusive news blast from the village office once a week leading up to July 23rd.

Initiatives implemented to date :

- Floral display outside the village municipal building (signage to be added).
- Floral craft with Lions Bay school.
- Another pot plant craft opportunity July 9th at Wade Park for children.
