REQUEST FOR EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST TO SIT ON THE BOARD OF VARIANCE

The Village of Lions Bay is looking for persons interested to sit on the Board of Variance. Appointments are for a 3 year term. The Board is an independent body with 3 volunteer members appointed by Council, that operates separately from Council to hear applications from people seeking a minor variance due to hardship from:

- (a) a bylaw (eg: the zoning bylaw) respecting the siting, size or dimensions of a building or other structure; or
- (b) a prohibition of a structural alteration or addition to a building or other structure while it constitutes a non-conforming use;

The Board may also:

- (c) hear an appeal of a Building Inspector's determination of damage to a non-conforming building; or
- (d) provide an exemption to relieve hardship from the early termination of a Land Use Contract.

View the Board of Variance Bylaw No. 502, 2016, as amended, [here](#). Familiarity with hearing procedures, building requirements and/or an ability to review and understand topographical surveys and building plans is an asset.

Please note that participation is in a volunteer capacity – there is no remuneration for serving on the Board of Variance. If appointed, your name will appear on the Village of Lions Bay website and your contact information will be provided to staff and other Board members.



Due to the unprecedented flooding experienced in some regions of BC, [Recycle BC has suspended the acceptance of glass at their receiving facilities in the Lower Mainland.](#)

Receiving facilities and recycling depots have also suspended receipt of Styrofoam and soft crinkly plastics. These changes became effective this week and, as a result, **Waste Control Services will not be collecting any glass put out at the curb.** Residents are encouraged to hold onto their glass and put it out once collection resumes. Those who normally take Styrofoam and crinkly plastics into the depots in North Vancouver are asked to similarly hold onto these materials.

Please do not take these materials to a depot – you will be turned away . Many of the depots and recycling facilities have run out of excess storage room and cannot accept any further material. At this time, paper, cardboard, containers, and soft plastics are being compacted and baled to increase storage space at the receiving stations so that curbside collection of this material can continue.

Logistics and supply chains have been severely impacted by the recent flooding and in the case of glass recycling, the end market facility is currently under water. With transportation corridors compromised, transfer of these recyclables to other facilities is not possible.

The situation is evolving rapidly, and further restrictions may be possible. We will provide updates as they become available. We apologize for the inconvenience and thank you for your patience.

CN crews have been working around the clock restoring tracks between Kamloops and Boston Bar and have been committed to ensure that essential goods continue moving along their tracks.

As a result, they have informed the Village of Lions Bay that residents may witness increased train traffic over the coming days as some of the goods that typically transit through the Fraser Canyon will be rerouted through the rail line that goes from Prince George to Vancouver.

Safety is a core value at CN, and they have made sure to inspect their infrastructure in the corridor before making the decision to move increased traffic. They will continue to assess the situation as repairs progress.

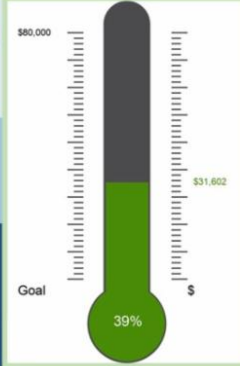
