ADDENDUM # 3

This Addendum forms part of the Contract Documents and is to be read, interpreted and coordinated with all other parts. The cost of all work contained herein shall be included in the Contract Sum. The following revisions supersede the information contained in the original drawings and specifications issued for the above named project to the extent referenced and shall become part thereof.

Q1: Item # 23, 24, and 26 are specified to be 45 cm x 45 cm (square). However the corresponding PDF files contain rectangular mock-ups. Which is correct?

A1: Rectangular

Q2: Item # 55 is specified as a Cedar blank that will be CNC routed and sandblasted.

A2: This should be an aluminium sign

Q3: Are the signs fully reflective?

A3: Yes

Q4: Is it possible to get a site plan with the locations for all the signage?

A4: No, we will work with the successful bidder on the exact locations of the signs

Q5: Is concrete footing part of Contractor's scope for installation or will this be supplied by Lions Bay?

A5: This is the responsibility of the bidder/proponent

Q6: Is there an existing completion schedule? Are there any scheduling requirements to consider?

A6: A schedule for completion will be developed in conjunction with the successful bidder

Q7: Is there room to consider cost saving methods of mounting brackets and structures?

A7: All bidders/proponents must provide installation costs for the mounting methods provided for in the ITT. Should a bidder/proponent wish, they may submit alternate mounting methods and costs separate to the original requirements

Q8: We assume the installation locations are within a 20-minute drive of each other.

A8: This is correct

Q9: We assume post-mounted signs are installed into earth that can be excavated by hand.

A9: This is correct
