## **WATER UPDATE**

Good afternoon,

We've had another minor slide within the Magnesia Creek watershed and a large volume of gravel and loose material came down the channel. The intake is now approximately 75% blocked and staff cannot relieve this blockage without lower flows and heavy equipment. In the interim, the Magnesia system is providing enough water to feed the Brunswick Beach neighbourhood thereby relieving some pressure from the Harvey Creek system.

Staff are hoping for a window of opportunity and continue to monitor the weather forecasts. Once the opportunity presents itself, clearing the blockage will be our priority.

I will provide further updates as things change.

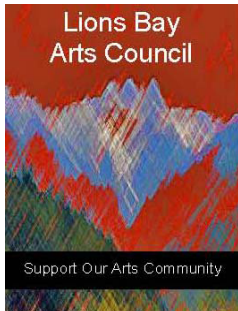
