**Broughton Hall**

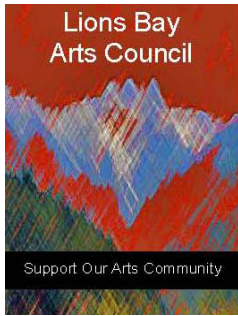
