Hello Lions Bay,

Last Friday's Remembrance Day ceremony was a meaningful and moving coming together of the community. It's one of the reasons I love this place so much. Thanks to all who participated, thanks to Trudi Luethy and her team for organising, and special thanks to Sue Forshaw for producing a Remembrance Day-themed heritage-quality Village quilt. We're looking for suggestions as to where it should be displayed.

Tomorrow's the big day: voting in our by-election and referendum all day in Broughton Hall. You're eligible to vote if you're a Canadian citizen 18 or older, currently a resident in Lions Bay for at least 30 days, having lived in B.C. for the past six months. [You may register in conjunction with voting with proof of these requirements.](#) You can also register as a non-resident property elector if you own property in Lions Bay but live elsewhere in BC. The qualifications and forms are on the Lions Bay website [here](#). By now you hopefully know the positions of our two candidates for Councillor; current Council members will not offer an endorsement but we certainly will be voting our personal preference on the day. As to our referendum (on borrowing up to \$3 mil. in several tranches over five years to support successful infrastructure grant awards), Council certainly does have an official position, and we ask for your support by voting Yes. VOTING DAY NOVEMBER 19, 2016

A reminder that you must provide one piece of identification when you vote at the by-election on Saturday, November 19, 2016. If you are not on the voters' list, you must provide two pieces of identification, verifying your address and identity. If you have moved to the Village in the last two to three years, you will most likely not be on the voters' list. Please see our website for a list of [acceptable forms](#) of identification as well as other voting information.

Note: you can also register as a non-resident property elector if you own property in Lions Bay but live elsewhere in BC. See the [forms](#) on our website and don't forget to bring your property tax notice with you as well.

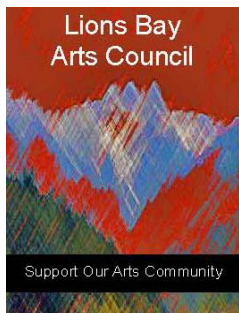
2017 MUNICIPAL GRANT APPLICATIONS
