The Village of Lions Bay is looking to develop ideas for the revitalization of the Lions Bay Beach Park (LBBP). To this end we are seeking volunteers to serve on an advisory group which will assist Municipal staff with public engagement and ideas for developing the park for the future.

The advisory group will be made up of three to five members with a diverse range of ages, backgrounds and interests. Meetings will be held approximately 4-5 times in the last four months of 2017.

All members of the community will be able to contribute to the Lions Bay Beach Park Revitalization Project through public feedback.

PAY PARKING

Please be advised that the parking meters have now been installed and are in use.

The 2016 Parking Survey showed there's a strong desire to be more accommodating to visitors by increasing parking opportunities. To that end the Village will be trialing Pay Parking at the Lions Bay Beach Park lot, the Kelvin Grove Beach Park lot, and the Sunset Trailhead lot. This Pay Parking trial period will continue for about 10 weeks, after which we will share our analysis with residents. Click on the button below to view more information on this 10 week trial.



As the Lions Bay Beach Park lot requires payment for both residents and visitors,

residents may wish to utilize the free street parking located in resident parking zones. In an effort to ensure that permit parking on the street is protected, any vehicle without an Annual Permit (or Contract or Guest Permit) will be ticketed.

is clearly displayed on your windshield to avoid a ticket.**

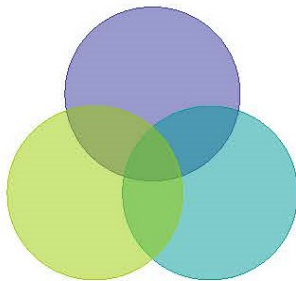
