STATUTORY HOLIDAY

The Village Office is closed for BC Day on Monday, August 7, 2017, reopening on Tuesday, August 8, 2017 at 10 am.

EXTREME FIRE HAZARD! ALL FIRES STRICTLY PROHIBITED! PLEASE, NO SMOKING ON TRAILS!

The Coastal Fire Centre has banned all open fires (including campfires). Please read the information bulletin below for more details.

Anyone found in contravention of a fire prohibition may be fined up to \$1,150. If your fire escapes and results in a wildfire, you may be fined anywhere from \$100,000 to \$1 million and be sentenced to one year in prison.

Smokers: Ensure your butts are completely extinguished and disposed of appropriately to ensure you don't accidentally cause a wildfire.

On Tuesday, August 8, 2017, beginning at 7:30 AM, contractors will be painting road lines and traffic markings throughout the Village of Lions Bay. Please move vehicles off public roads or away from the affected areas in order to avoid interfering with the line painting works. Residents are advised to plan for and expect minor traffic interruptions in some areas as needed.

Please Note: The Village of Lions Bay will not be liable for road paint overspray onto adjacent cars parked within these parking areas at the time of line painting nor is the municipality liable for paint damage claims from motorists who cross wet paint lines.

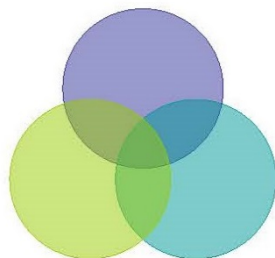
developing the park for the future.
