## **CONGRATULATIONS STEPHEN SANDERSON**

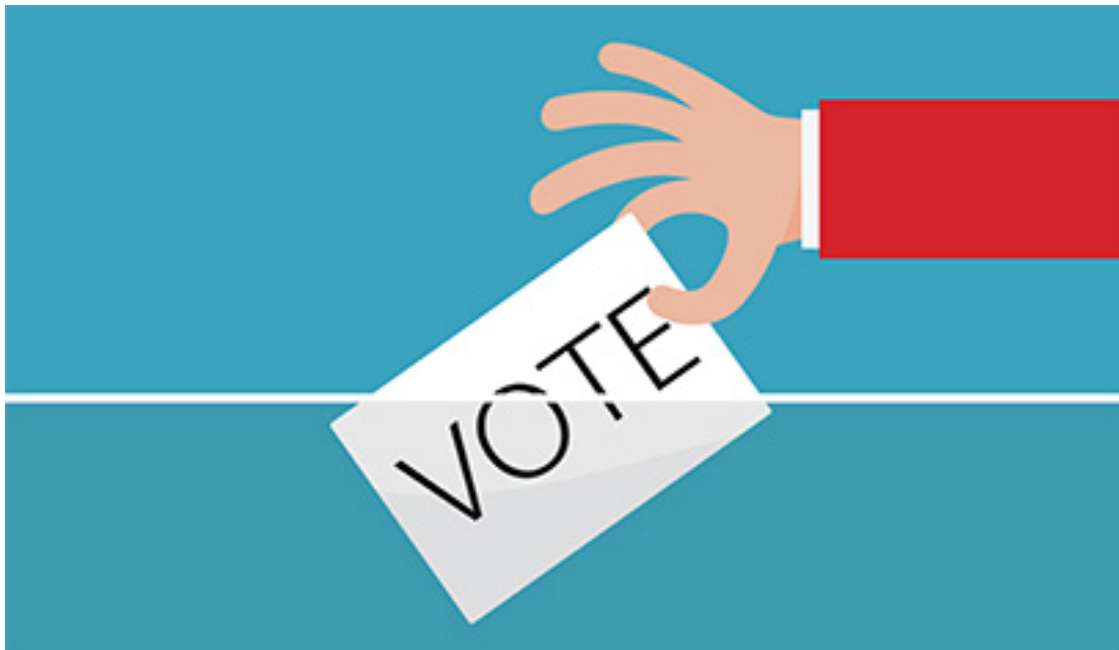

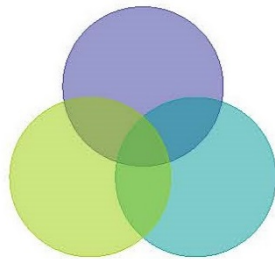
## BY-ELECTION OCTOBER 21, 2017



The Village of Lions Bay will hold a by-election for the office of one Councillor on Saturday, October 21, 2017. The term for the position will end in October 2018, when the next general local election will be held. The by-election is being held to fill the vacant Councillor position.

The nomination period will be open from 10 am on Tuesday, September 5, 2017 until 4 pm on Friday, September 15, 2017. Nomination documents are available at the Village Office, or [online](#).

Eligible voters will be able to cast their ballots at Broughton Hall on October 21st or during the advance voting opportunity on Wednesday, October 11, 2017. Electors may also vote by mail ballot.
