## From the Mayor's Desk

Hello Lions Bay,

The Lions Bay Beach community advisory committee kicked off this week, and already the ideas are flowing. The goal is to have a holistic, multi-year recommendation to Council in time for 2018 budget deliberations, starting soon. A reminder that the by-election for one vacant Councillor seat will be held Sat. Oct. 21 in Broughton Hall, with early voting Oct. 11 and mail ballot voting as usual. Details are [here](#). Council recently changed the Election Procedures Bylaw to allow for officially-promulgated All-Candidates meetings, in this case to be held this Thursday, Sep. 28 at 7 pm in Broughton Hall. Please come down to hear what candidates Scott Ando, Norm Barmeier and Jaime Cunliffe have in mind for the one-year term until province-wide municipal elections a year later, and beyond. With Council firing on all cylinders, electing the right candidate is important to best serve Lions Bay.

The annual local government bunfight, the Union of BC Municipalities convention, is downtown next week. CAO Peter DeJong and I will be attending meetings with Ministers, ministry staff and Crown corporations to hash out Lions Bay issues like highway noise and hydro transmission lines, and in concert with fellow MVRD

members Anmore, Belcarra and Bowen, present formal proposals for changes to the funding realities of small Metro municipalities.

## BY-ELECTION OCTOBER 21, 2017



The Village of Lions Bay will hold a by-election for the office of one Councillor on Saturday, October 21, 2017. The term for the position will end in October 2018, when the next general local election will be held. The by-election is being held to fill the vacant Councillor position.

The candidates are: **Norman Barmeier; Jamie Cunliffe; Scott Ando.** An All Candidates Meeting will be held in Broughton Hall on Thursday, September 28th at 7:00 pm.

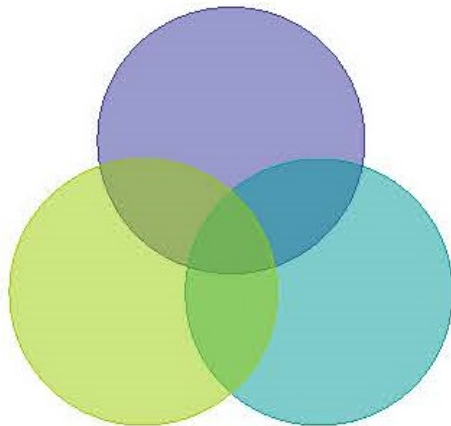
