

VILLAGE UPDATE

Monday, January 29, 2018



Good afternoon,

Due to the heavy rainfall and high winds, both Magnesia and Harvey Creeks are running high and continue to move significant debris down the channels. The Magnesia Creek intake is plugged and consequently not able to supply the Village with water. Harvey Creek supply is also diminished due to what we believe to be a combination of debris and vegetation plugging the screens. Compounding the issue is a landslide that has blocked the access road to the Harvey Creek Intake.

In light of these events I would please ask you to conserve water to ensure the demand can continue to be met by the diminished Harvey system.

Clearing both intakes requires that we wait until we meet specific geotechnical and meteorological criteria before we can safely travel up the access roads. In addition,

we will need to have the Harvey Creek access road cleared of the landslide. Public Works will continue to monitor the situation and issue further updates as required.
