## **Public Works has lifted the Water Conservation Advisory**

High water flows from the additional rainfall overnight appear to have self-scoured the Harvey Creek intake thereby removing the blockage. An analysis of the flows entering the treatment plant through the intakes indicates that Harvey Creek supply is sufficient to remove the Water Conservation Advisory. The Magnesia Creek supply is still diminished and is only functioning at 5% of its capacity.

Unfortunately, due to safe work requirements regarding excessive rainfalls on the access roads, staff have not been able to access either site and until then Harvey will continue to supply the bulk of our potable water needs.
