FOREST FIRE UPDATE

Lions Bay Residents:

The Village Office is being updated by BC Wildfire Services and Fire Chief Oliver as changes arise with respect to the active forest fire burning just north of Lions Bay near the Tunnel Point hiking trail. Please note this trail has been CLOSED until further notice.

According to the BC Wildfire Incident Commander, although it is not under control at this time, it is anticipated that it will be under control later today. It is expected that the fire will smoke more vigorously this afternoon when the sun hits the ground at the location of the fire and as the breeze picks up.

The fire does NOT pose any risk to homes in Lions Bay and is not moving significantly in any direction.

There are 18 firefighters and two helicopters actively working on this fire.
