# LIONS BAY COMMUNITY GARDEN



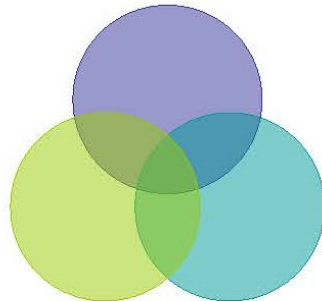
Enjoy growing your own veggies? Have you ever wanted to start a vegetable garden or need extra space to expand your own vegetable garden and don't have enough space at home?
