WATER CONSERVATION LEVEL 2

Effective immediately, the Village of Lions Bay is moving to Water Conservation Level 2.

Due to the continued dry weather and lack of precipitation, our water supply is dwindling. Creek flows have dropped below 350 GPM and consumption continues to be high. The Municipality asks that everyone conserve as much water as possible so that we have sufficient supply in case of a fire, which continues to be a major concern for the community.

What does this mean for residents?

- Sprinkling times for lawns will be reduced to one day per week during allotted times:

- Even numbered addresses on Mondays only from 4 a.m. - 9 a.m.
- Odd numbered addresses on Thursdays only from 4 a.m. - 9 a.m.
- Watering flowers, vegetables, planters, trees, and shrubs can only be by hand using spring-loaded nozzle, containers or Drip Irrigation.
- Sprinklers and soaker hoses are prohibited.
- Do not wash outdoor impermeable surfaces, cars or boats other than in strict compliance with bylaw conditions.
- Refrain from filling pools and spas.

We are looking for support from everyone in the community to find creative ways to save water and help spread the word.

If the situation improves in the coming weeks, Water Conservation Level 2 will be rescinded. If the water shortage becomes more severe, the Municipality will move to Water Conservation Level 3, which prohibits virtually all outdoor water use.
