The Village of Lions Bay is moving down to Water Conservation Level 1

Thanks to the rainfall received and the conservation efforts of residents we are able to return to our normal status at Water Conservation Level 1. Creek flows have risen above 350 GPM while Municipality-wide daily consumption has dropped to approximately 260 GPM. The Municipality would like to thank everyone for their conservation efforts.

What's next?

Conservation Level 1 remains in effect until September 30, 2018 in accordance with the Village of Lions Bay Outdoor Water Use Bylaw 484, 2015, after which restrictions will be lifted should the weather continue to be conducive.

- Sprinkling can only occur between 4 a.m. - 9 a.m. as follows:
 - Even numbered addresses on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays
 - Odd numbered addresses on Tuesdays, Thursdays, and Sundays
