



Lions Bay Beach Park REVITALIZATION

The Lions Bay Beach Park Advisory Committee (LBPPAC) is conducting a survey to collect information on residents and beach park users as to how they are utilizing the park and to assist the Lions Bay Beach Park Advisory Committee in planning and prioritizing their recommendations to Council on the park.

Issues include:

- The toddler playground play structure has reached the end of its useful life and replacement parts are unavailable
- Two large trees near the park and marina entrances have been heavily topped and are showing signs of decay - both trees present a liability and safety risk
- The boat and kayak rack on the north side of the park is deteriorating
- The washrooms are considered by many to be inadequate
- The structural timbers of the Lori Beck Memorial Pavilion gazebo are rotting and cannot be repaired
- The wooden staircase leading from the upper playgrounds to the lower sloped area is rotting
- And more...

There is an opportunity to make improvements to the park but we need to understand the community's priorities.
