

THE VILLAGE OF LIONS BAY

By-law #52

A By-law of the Village of Lions Bay  
to regulate the discharge of firearms.

\*\*\*\*\*

The Council of the Village of Lions Bay, in open meeting assembled  
enacts as follows:

In this By-law the terms "Firearms" shall have the same meaning as  
contained in the Firearms Act, being chapter 145 and the Wildlife Act,  
being chapter 55 of the statues of the Province of British Columbia.

1. No person shall discharge within or into the boundaries of the  
Village of Lions Bay a firearm, including air or spring  
operated weapons,
2. No person within the Village Boundaries shall carry a firearm  
while off the limits of their property. This will not include  
firearms being carried by it's owner in a vehicle while  
immediately leaving or arriving at Village Boundaries, or any  
person lawfully carrying a Firearm in accord with any  
Provincial or Federal Permit of Licence.

Any person who violates any provisions of this By-law shall be liable  
on conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.00 together with the cost  
of conviction.

This By-law may be cited as the "Village of Lions Bay Firearm By-law  
#52."
