

VILLAGE OF LIONS BAY

INDEMNIFICATION BY-LAW NO. 172, 1988

A By-law to provide for the indemnification of members of Council, Firemen, and Officers and employees pursuant to Section 262 of the Municipal Act.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act provides that Council may by by-law indemnify their municipalities Council members, Firemen , Officers and employees thereof against any claim for damages against a Council member, Fireman, Officer or employee arising out of the performance of his duties.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Village of Lions Bay in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. In this by-law "officer", "employee", "Council Member", and "Firemen" includes persons formerly holding such positions.
2. The municipality will indemnify its Council members, Firemen, officers and employees against a claim for damages against a Council member, Fireman, officer or employee arising out of the performance of his duties and, in addition, pay legal costs incurred in a court proceeding arising out of the claim.
3. The municipality will not seek indemnity against its Council members, Firemen , officers and employees where the actions of those Council members, Firemen , officers and employees result in a claim for damages against the municipality by a third party unless the Council member, Fireman, officer or employee has been grossly negligent or has wilfully acted contrary to the terms of his employment or to an order of a superior.
4. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Lions Bay Indemnification By-law No. 172, 1988."
5. The Officers and Employees Indemnification By-Law No. 145 is hereby repealed.






