CHANGES TO WORKS YARD GARBAGE & FOOD WASTE DROP-OFF PROGRAM

The Saturday Works Yard garbage and food waste drop-off will be discontinued next week. You can still drop off food waste and garbage (only) at the Works Yard this week, Saturday, July 30th from 8 am – 11am.

The Friday Works Yard drop-off program between 6 am and 8 am will continue.

Curbside time slots remain the same (see below).

If you miss Works Yard drop off times, **DO NOT LEAVE YOUR GARBAGE AND ORGANIC WASTE AT THE WORKS YARD GATE OR THROW YOUR GARBAGE OVER THE FENCE AT THE WORKS YARD** – bears have climbed the fence and gotten into this garbage, threatening the program for all.

GARBAGE AND ORGANICS COLLECTION SCHEDULES – No Change

7:30 - 9 am: Bayview Place-Upper Bayview, Mountain-Timbertop-Sunset, and all streets leading off these (central Lions Bay above the highway).

9 - 10 am: Highview-Oceanview, Panorama, Kelvin Grove Way, and all streets leading off these.

10 am - 1 pm: All other neighbourhoods (lower Kelvin Grove, Brunswick, central Lions Bay below the highway, etc.).

Please put your waste out as close to 7:30 am, 9 am or 10 am as possible.

Clean recyclables should be placed outside your home in the Friday morning time slots (above) or as close as possible to those times or, if you have to head out, as you leave home.

Some of our bears are still lingering in the village however, we hope the heat wave will see them moving up the mountain where it is cooler and their natural food sources should now be available. Until then, they are most likely to shelter from the heat during the day and be more active at night.

Please remember to:

- **keep your property free of any attractants** which will also make it less enticing for bears to hang around;
- **pick fruit and ripen off out of reach of bears;**
- make sure your **bird feeder is out of reach** and bring it in at night;
- report bear sightings: we are tracking sightings reported through our website which is how we know some bears are still around. If you spot a bear, as always, please let us know at www.lionsbaybearsmart.ca.
