QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day October 15, 2022;
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed; and,
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election in British Columbia or being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CANDIDATE INFORMATION MEETINGS – REVISED DATE

A candidate information session for prospective Mayor and Councillor candidates, and any interested persons, will be held on **August 30, 2022** at 7 pm, in the Lions Bay Council Chambers, 400 Centre Road.

School Trustee candidates, and any interested persons, may attend an information session on August 31, 2022 at 6 pm at the West Vancouver Municipal Hall Council Chamber, 750 17th Street or join online via Webex at election.westvancouver.ca.
