2022 General Local Election

Nomination Documents

The deadline for submission of Candidate Nomination documents is Friday, September 9, 2022 at 4 pm.

Nomination documents may be delivered by hand, mail, or other delivery service, or by email, with originals to follow. If delivered by email, original nomination documents must be received by 4 pm, Friday, September 16, 2022.

Declaration of Candidacy

Residents who are interested in running for Council are invited to submit a 250 word document which includes their name, the office for which they are running and a brief biography no later than 4 pm on Friday, September 9, 2022. Submissions will be included in a special edition of the Village Update that will be run on Monday, September 12.

Any such materials should also contain an authorizing statement from the candidate:

- the name of the financial agent,
- the words "authorized by" in front of the financial agent's name*, and
- a B.C. phone number, or B.C. mailing address or email address at which the financial agent can be contacted.

* *Note: the financial agent is often the candidate themselves.*

There can be no forward-looking statements regarding candidates reasons for running or their election platform in this 250 word statement. Those that do not comply with the terms outlined above will not be published.

Candidate Platform

In addition to the above Declaration of Candidacy opportunity, the Election Advertising and Campaigning Policy offers each candidate the opportunity to provide Municipal staff with a PDF document of their election platform. The document should be less than 10 MB in size and may be updated by the candidate once during the election period, by providing a replacement PDF document to staff. The candidate platform will be posted on the 2022 General Local Election webpage as soon as practicable following the declaration of an election by voting, scheduled for September 19, 2022.

All Candidates Meeting

An all-candidates meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 27, 2022 in the Village Hall (time to be announced).

There must be a minimum of two candidates (including stand-ins) attending for an All-Candidates event to proceed and any candidates unable to attend may send someone to stand-in for them.

Resignation of Chief Election Officer

Due to his concerns about the perception of bias and his ability to satisfy potential candidates and members of the public in terms of his statutory duties as the Chief Election Officer, CAO Peter DeJong has tendered to Council his resignation as the Chief Election Officer effective immediately. The Deputy Chief Election Officers (DCEOs), Linda Brick, Hayley Cook and Pamela Rooke will continue to carry out all election duties under the *Local Government Act*.
