Dennis Back has worked in local and provincial government for many years and has held a variety of administrative and management positions during this time.

He served with the District of North Vancouver for 12 years, including a period as Chief Administrative Officer. Prior to that, he worked with the City of Vancouver for ten years, as well as the City of Powell River, City of Penticton, Town of Oliver, and as Executive Assistant to a Provincial Cabinet Minister.

Since 2009, Dennis has been doing contract work for municipalities, including the City of Penticton, Squamish-Lillooet Regional District, City of White Rock, Powell River Regional District, District of Lillooet, City of North Vancouver, Bowen Island Municipality, City of Burnaby, and most recently with the Village of Belcarra.
