Environment Canada has issued a heat warning predicting high temperatures or humidity conditions which are expected to pose an elevated risk of heat illnesses such as heat stroke or heat exhaustion. Environment Canada and local Medical Health Officers expect an increase in health and safety risks from heat and are advising the public to take precautions.

The Village of Lions Bay will open a cooling center Monday, August 14th, and Tuesday August 15th from 1pm - 5pm for villagers at high risk including: (max 6 people in the room)

The cooling center is located on the upper level of the municipal building behind the council chambers (3rd door).
