The Village has introduced a new format for Guest Parking Permits. Guest Permits allow residents' guest to park in Permit and street Pay parking zones (not Pay lots i.e Sunset Trail Parking Lot, Lions Bay Beach Park Lot, Kelvin Grove Beach Park Lot).

Please note that as of **November 1, 2023**, the current pass format will not be valid and use of these passes after this date may incur a parking infraction.

Please come by the Village Office between 9am and 4pm Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays) to pick up a sheet of the new guest passes. Passes are limited to one sheet of six Guest Parking Permits per day, per address. The Village appreciates your cooperation in ensuring the success of the parking management system.

# A message from Bear Smart






As Halloween approaches, images of scary bats become commonplace. This is the perfect time of year to counter bat myths and do something to help bats, by taking part in International Bat Week.

Please join the Lions Bay Butterflyway team for a free seed-sharing and planting workshop on **November 4** at 10 am at the Village Hall. (400 Centre Road) We have collected lots of seeds from our pollinator-friendly plants and we would love to see them distributed throughout the village to help support local bees, butterflies, flies and beetles that depend on nectar and pollen for their development. Come and learn some of the fundamentals

of how to grow native plants from seed. We will provide seeds, pots, soil and scones. All you need to provide is enthusiasm and the ability to nurture some seeds throughout the winter. If you would like to take seeds away with you, bring some envelopes. In the spring you can plant your own pollinator garden or donate your seedlings to other gardeners.
