# FINAL UTILITY NOTICE

PAYMENT DEADLINE: December 31, 2023

Just a reminder that your 2023 Utility Notices are due by December 31, 2023. Please ensure that all payments are delivered and dated no later than December 31, 2023. This includes: Electronic Payments, Credit Card Payments through on-line portal, or by Cheque.

Due to the Office Closure over the Holidays from December 23, 2023 to January 1, 2024, cheques can be dropped off through the door slot. They will be posted via the date on the cheque. Cheques arriving on or after January 2, 2024 will be processed as a late payment.

Please note: Any unpaid Utility Bills as of January 1, 2024 will be rolled over into Property Taxes owing as per Bylaw No. 2, s.6.(2).(c). whereupon daily interest will be incurred.

For the entire week starting **Monday November 27th**, Public Works will be conducting mandatory watermain flushing between 8 a.m. and 3 p.m.

#### Why do we need to flush watermains?

Mineral deposits, biofilm and sediment that accumulate in watermains over time need to be removed by regular high-velocity flushing.

#### Do residents need to do anything?

During flushing, residents may experience discoloured water and pressure fluctuations. Residents are advised to avoid using water as far as possible when a given zone is being flushed (signs will be placed), because while the water remains safe and potable, use during flushing will draw suspended solids into the house system, which can clog water filters, softeners and tap aerators, discolour laundry and taste wrong.

After flushing is completed in your zone, clear water lines by running the cold water tap closest to the incoming service line (remove screens/aerators on the tap). The municipality is required by the health authorities to perform regular flushing and accepts no liability for inconvenience or damage caused by low pressure or turbid water use.


