UPDATES FROM THE MUNICIPALITY

The Village Office will not be open to the public today, due to highway conditions too uncertain for sufficient staff to safely drive in.

FROM THE YARD



Public Works crew members got in this morning before the shift started, and will likely be staying after it ends, with two snowplows in operation. We had salted at 7 pm yesterday to tide us over until the snow started around midnight; it's still coming down, but expected to taper off starting around 5 pm. Driving conditions will be tricky for a while, with temperatures hovering right around freezing, making snow and ice as slippery as it gets. Until we get the roads back to black please do not venture out without full-snowflake winter tires—the highway and the Village are strewn with cars trying other variants.

BC Hydro's input this week is that as part of equipment replacement underway for the past several months in our area, Lions Bay is currently being fed from the north. When protection trips on any of the multiple lines feeding the large substations in the area, usually for weather-related snow or tree contact reasons, system assessment takes a few minutes, and Lions Bay can usually be restored relatively quicker than some areas, which have experienced outages lasting several hours or more. Intermittent power failures today have been short, but if one is prolonged as we move toward evening, staff will open Broughton Hall with its generator, lights, plugs and furnace.
