FROM THE YARD



Federal and provincial weather alerts provided to local governments indicate with high certainty that several further Pacific disturbances will collide with the arctic air still in place, starting mid-afternoon today, Thursday Jan. 18. The most recent bulletin for Howe Sound is forecasting light snow, with a risk of freezing rain bringing very challenging travel conditions (icy & slippery surfaces, reduced visibility), and possible damage to trees, power lines and vulnerable structures due to the extra weight of snow and ice. Precipitation is forecast to change to rain on Friday as warm air returns, with possible water pooling and localized flooding as snow melts. In addition, there is an outflow wind warning in effect for Howe Sound. Further Village Updates will be issued if the forecast changes, but for now, please be aware of the possibility for extreme weather and power outages through Saturday.
