UPDATES FROM THE MUNICIPALITY



The Village of Lions Bay updates its five-year Financial Plan each year, as required by the BC Community Charter. The purpose of the five-year Financial Plan is to provide a budgetary framework for the Village to plan the management of its resources, revenues and expenditures in order to best serve the community.


The Village is required by provincial law to balance its operating and capital budgets each year. Simply put, the money raised must equal the money spent. To ensure a balanced budget, the Village can (a) increase its revenues via property taxes and/or user fees; and/or (b) manage expenditures through adapting or reducing the cost of programs and/or services. The five-year Financial Plan must be adopted by Council on or before May 15th.

Core Budget

The budgeting process begins with a discussion of the core budget, which encompasses the Village's normal operating expenses and revenues associated with the day-to-day provision of services. The core budget is developed with reference to the prior year approved budget to maintain current levels of service and incorporates inflationary and other adjustments as necessary.

The preliminary core budget for 2024 incorporates a 6% increase in property tax. Each 1% increase in property taxes equates to approximately \$17,845 in additional revenue to the Village (\$30 per household).

The preliminary core budget also incorporates 5% increase in user rates for water, sewer, and solid waste.




Supplementals

New programs and/or services such as increased costs and staffing implications are incorporated into the core budget moving forward or as a one-time expense and/or a one-time revenue and are referred to as supplemental requests.

The Committee of the Whole met February 6, 2024 to receive presentations from departmental leaders regarding their supplemental requests and will discuss priorities for inclusion in the 2024 budget at their upcoming meeting on February 13.

Supplemental requests being discussed amount to \$6.4 million dollars; significant requests include (a) new fire truck; (b) replacement of highway tank; (c) Lions Bay Beach Park revitalization (73% grant funded); Klatt building renovation (100% grant funded); and drainage. A full list of supplemental requests is available for review in the Committee of the Whole package posted on the Village website.
