Our Environment:

Our Halloween Fireworks show produces approximately 3.8kg of CO2.

We have purchased offsets equal to a reduction of almost 1 metric ton of CO2! By purchasing carbon offsets to make each show not only carbon neutral but carbon NEGATIVE. Actually, our carbon offsets are over 250X greater than our carbon release!

We purchase carbon offsets through Planetair, a Canadian non-profit leader in the fight against climate change founded in 2005, recommended by Équiterre and the David Suzuki Foundation. We have chosen to support the Canada Reforestation project that finances both Gold Standard-certified GHG reductions, and reforestation projects in Canada that offer various benefits such as land rehabilitation, forest ecosystems upgrading and the creation of green spaces. The new plantations also reduce water runoff, improve air quality and encourage the creation of green corridors for the benefit of biodiversity.
