

Ten years have passed since our community lost 7 year old Erin Moore in a tragic hiking accident above our Village. Each year since, a hike is held in her memory. The Moore family invites all in the community to walk in her memory at 10:30am on Sunday, December 8 starting at the very top of Oceanview Road, looping up to Erin's Enchanted Forest.

Erin's Enchanted Forest continues to be a wonderland of small decorations like colourful toadstools, butterflies, painted rocks and inspirational hangings; you may wish to add a decoration. You may also choose to dress colourfully.

The walk takes about an hour and, as usual, we will have hot chocolate, coffee and chilli after the walk. If walking is too much for you please don't stay away but come anyway and remember Erin over a bowl of chilli.
