## **Good News For Lions Bay Beach!**

Monday's beach water sample results were reported at 2:00 am this morning:

LOCATION	COLONY-FORMING UNITS PER 100 MILLILITRES
Lions Bay Beach A	41
Lions Bay Beach B	36
Kelvin Grove A	10
Kelvin Grove B	82
Brunswick A	18
Brunswick B	<5

The 5-sample rolling average *E. coli* result at Lions Bay Beach is now determined by Vancouver Coastal Health at 139 colony-forming units per 100 ml sample, under the 200 unit limit, and they will unpost the beach today. Signage will be removed by the municipality. *E. coli* samples are taken by the municipality weekly on Mondays, immediately couriered to the VCH lab, cultured, and usually reported by them on Thursday morning. Sampling frequency is increased in an attempt to remove short term spikes from the average. Lions Bay Beach's exceedances have been long term, and may return depending on next Monday's sample but for now, **Lions Bay Beach is fully open**.
