



## **UPDATES FROM THE MUNICIPALITY**



#### WATER METERING

Lions Bay's multi-year universal water metering project is underway, with specification and engineering approaching completion and procurement begun. We know that residents have questions and concerns about metering and we address some starting today on the Village website at ALL-ZONE ALL-PROPERTY WATER METERING 2025/26.



#### **SOLID WASTE**

Under our collection contract with Recycle BC, residential recycling—card/paper, and metal, plastic and glass containers—MUST be collected curbside by them (they use the same contractor we use for compostable and landfill waste), and not at the Community Recycling Depot which takes only styrofoam, batteries, bulbs, soft plastics and consumer electronic e-waste (at the Public Works Yard, 5 Tidewater Way, **Fridays 6-9 am** and **Saturdays 8-11am**). The Yard also has capacity for wildlife-attractant compostable and landfill waste, but all other residential solid waste must either be collected curbside (calendar here), or taken by residents to the **North Shore Recycling and Waste Centre**, 30 Riverside Dr., North Vancouver, of which Lions Bay is a fee-paying member.



#### **BEACH WATER QUALITY**

This Monday's beach sample results delivered at 02:00 this morning continue to keep *E. coli* averages below Vancouver Coastal Health's Investigation or Advisory limits:
