# IMPORTANT NOTICE To Our Valued Lions Bay Postal Box Customers

With constructive feedback received from the Village Council and local community, effective September 2, 2025, customers with expired PO Boxes in Lions Bay will be required to renew their box or open a new PO Box through the West Vancouver Post Office. This change applies to all customers receiving renewal notices. No action is required until you receive a renewal notice.

#### What You Need to Know:

- There are two post box categories: 'Prime Mode' are no cost, 'Convenience' require a rental fee. Most Lions Bay post boxes are 'Prime Mode'.
- Renewal is required annually: When your Lions Bay PO Box is due for renewal, you will
  receive a notice card in your post box and will need to renew your service at the West
  Vancouver PO.
- If the box is a 'Convenience' (not Prime Mode) you will be required to pay the applicable fees when you renew.
- New Box Assignment: If you do not currently have a box and have a civic address, a new Prime Mode PO Box will be assigned to you in the Lions Bay post boxes, to do this you must bring Government Issues Photo Id and proof of residence to the West Vancouver Post Office.
- Parcel pick-ups will still be available at the Caulfield PO, no change here.
- Effective September 2, 2025, please visit the post office at West Vancouver PO for any of your postal box needs. Whether you need to renew, close, or open a postal box, our team at West Vancouver PO is ready to assist you.


