Upcoming Traffic Impacts

Crews will be working on Oceanview Rd next week, between the Hwy 99 northbound offramp and Crosscreek Road, to install conduit in support of the "all zone" water metering project, completely grant funded by the province.

Work is planned Monday - Friday, between 7:00am and 5:00pm. Single lane alternating traffic is planned from Wednesday - Friday, 7:00am and 5:00pm. Please expect minor delays and we thank you for your patience while we complete this important work.

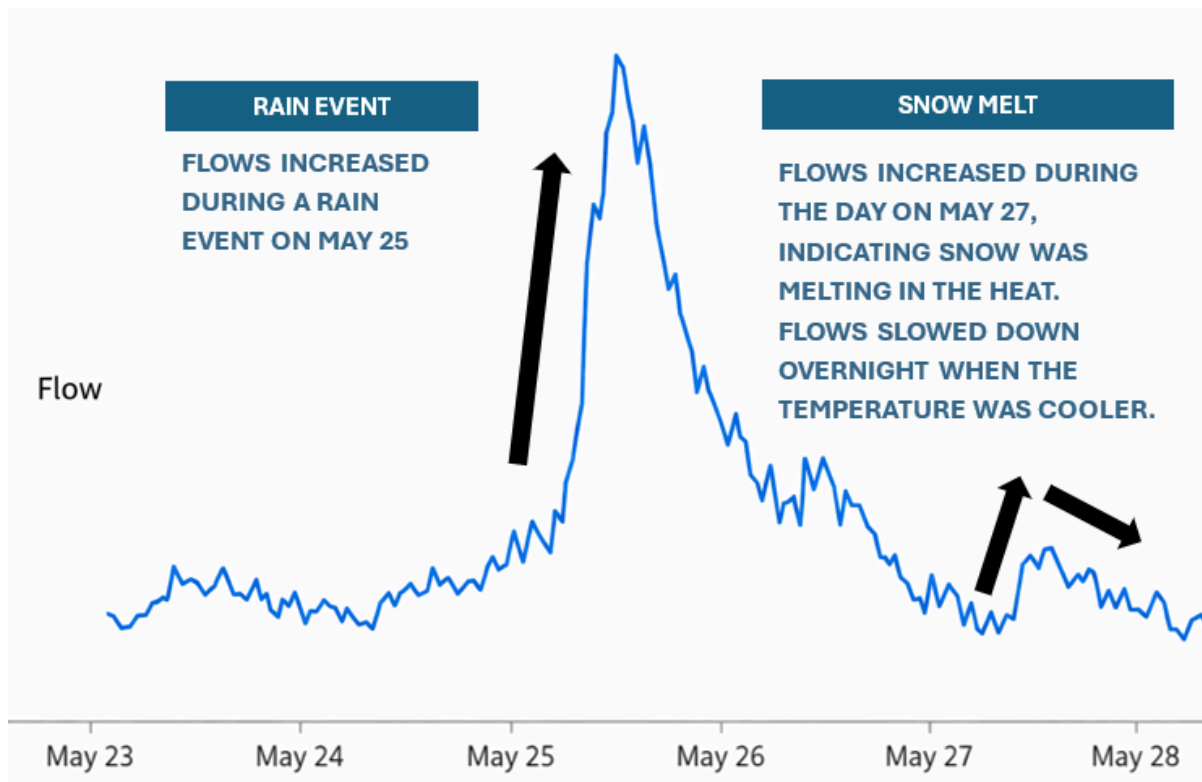
Bus Stop Update

Staff received great news this week; the next bundle of grant funding has been secured for the second phase of the bus stop project at Lions Bay Ave / Islevie Pl. We are working hard to have the new concrete sidewalks installed and the bus stop in operation before July 1. Installation of the bus shelter structure itself will follow after delivery to the Village.

Water Conservation

Conservation level 1 began on June 1, which affects lawn watering activities throughout the Village. Please review the restrictions in Schedule A of the Outdoor Water Use Bylaw No. 484, 2015, found [here](#).

Operations staff are actively monitoring the creek flows with equipment setup above the intakes. Staff have been observing flow trends over the last few months indicative of snow pack melting, however, flows are starting to slow down indicating that the snow pack is almost gone. This is earlier than normal, but not yet concerning. The graph below from our flow monitoring equipment is an example of the trends being observed.



How we are preparing:

Operations staff will be setting up the third creek intake, on Alberta Creek, in the coming weeks. This will let us take water out of Alberta to supplement the regular water supply from Magnesia and Harvey just in case flows get too low.

As staff continue to monitor the trends, please be prepared to adjust your water use to ensure adequate supply is available for everyone. It is important to conserve water so our tanks are full for emergency and firefighting use if ever needed. Stay tuned for further updates from Operations as we continue to monitor the creeks.

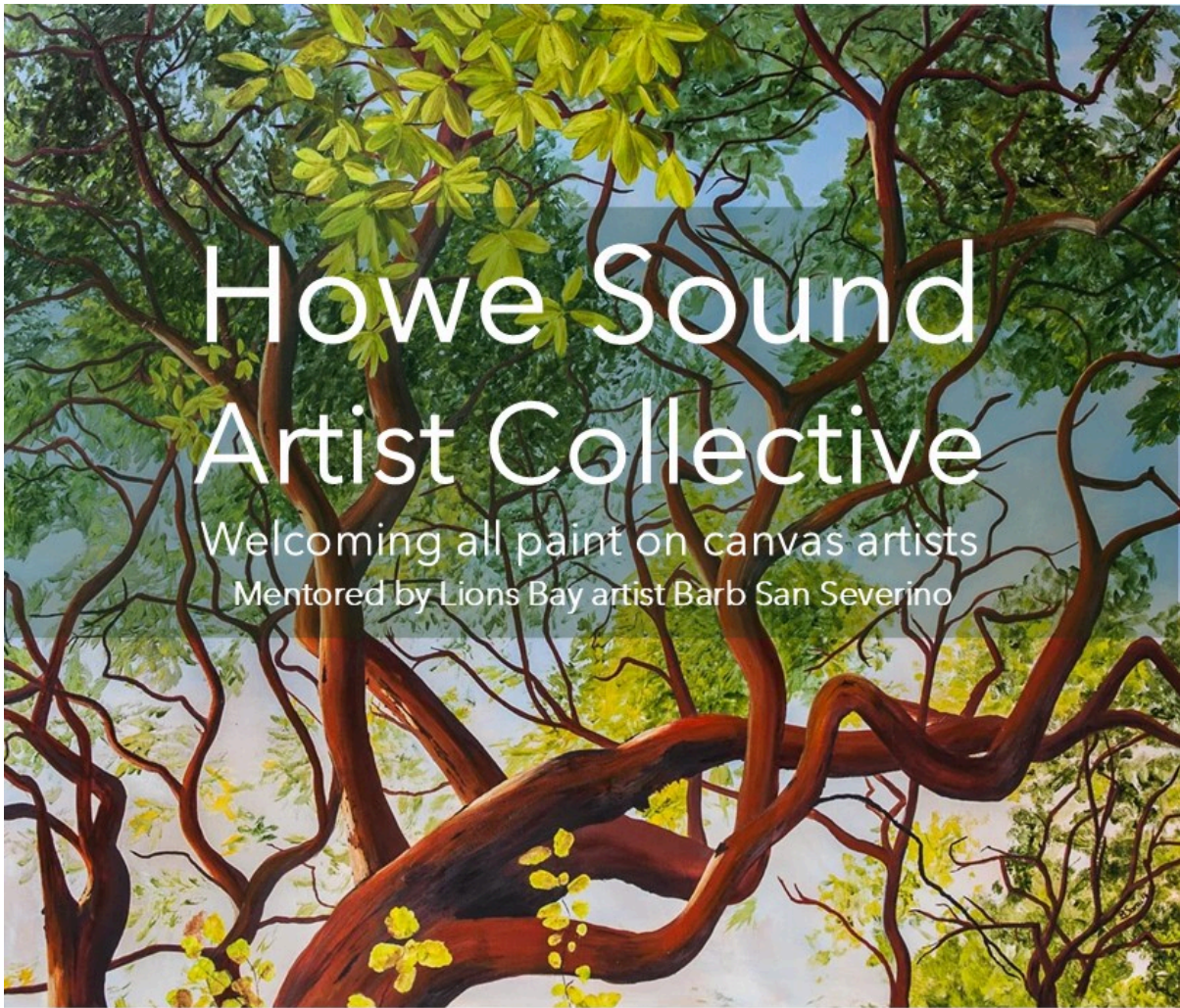
